Minutes

Directors Report:

- Need to delegate the marching band platform, buy with grant from Roosevelt Foundation
 - Hannah to send link to Raj
 - Raj will buy and seek reimbursement from Roosevelt Foundation
- Ask Milo & Sasha as historians to be coordinate pictures for yearbook submissions as band liaison. Ask Amy Noji what she needs.

Treasurer's Report:

- \$47K balance
- Awaiting Husky Clean-up revenue, ASB reimbursement for mini-retreat costs, band lab fees
- Outstanding payments to clinician Mr. Mechin (will provide itemized invoice) and drum heads.
- Accept band lab fee payments at the concert

Chair Report:

- RHS to audit performing arts boosters
- SPS rule? Regarding student activities saying that any funds generated should go into ASB
- Needs review and discussion with the school
- Any ASB payments require a PO. Buses, clinicians, marching band uniforms, etc need to be invoiced beforehand. Reimbursement is harder.
- Bus expenses are highly mitigated if using yellow buses vs. motor coaches, need to be mindful of when buses arrive/depart to use yellow buses
- Bass Trombones – desperately need a new one – ask Roosevelt Foundation for emergency grant?
 - 5-6K per instrument
 - Better prices can come with multiple instrument purchases at once
 - Jazz Booster fundraiser may be the fastest path to a bass trombone
 - Fund-a-need – new instruments at concert
- Uniforms
 - New uniform for Sydney in the works
 - Dry cleaning at end of year – the school pays
- Senior gifts – graduation cords w/pens?
- Fundraising
 - Swag sales at concert
 - Husky clean-up next year
- Service Hours
 - Marching Band game – 4 hours
 - Pep Band game – 2 hours

Events:

 - Building permits are needed for each concert, filed with Kristi Mathews

- Ask Sven if we can get a group shot of concert band for yearbook?
- Spring Band Camp, May 26-28, Camp Casey
 - No longer going to Canada
 - Work on marching, reflection of fall band camp
 - Need to know about food...when do we arrive/depart. Mirror fall band camp.
 - Trip commitment form & save the date
- Musical runs in early June – Hannah is directing the pit orchestra, band students may be involved
- Sunday, June 11 Neighborhood Parade and Picnic
 - Permit with Seattle Police, drop flyers at houses/businesses, RHS Building Permit for commons (Sarah T), parade route defined
- Thursday, June 22nd, Spring Fling Concert
 - Awards for students, senior gifts
- Sunday, June 25th, Pride Parade, \$350 fee. In uniforms with rainbow baseball caps, possibly a pride t-shirt. Take light rail.
- June 28th, Graduation, all bands in concert attire, need busses, water, etc.
