## **Treasurer's Report:**

- Balance is 40,000 (lowest its been since Raj has been here)
- \$9,000 UW Husky clean-up, still not received, Mark continues to email- Raj may make a visit.
- Still looking for around \$4500 in reimbursements, but we are waiting for those to go through (ASB and Roosevelt Foundation)
- Around \$8229 raised for spring band camp (paypal) plus there may be some checks- we've awarded 3 scholarships and so far we've spent \$1700. Commitment for 55 to come to camp.
- Lab fees are still coming in (from 86 students total) Looks like only 24 people haven't responded about lab fees.
